Presentation files should be identified with the presenter's last name and brought on a USB key or CD on the day of the presentation;

Only presentations in PowerPoint or PDF format will be accepted;

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## Urban Design Model Presentation Directives

Models will be displayed throughout the duration of the conference;  
Models should include your name, university and program;  
A brief write up of your urban design project should be integrated into the model to explain context, challenges and planning innovations;  
Models should be submitted to the registration desk for safekeeping.

## Poster Presentation Directives

Final draft of poster should be sent in advance to [amanda.crompton@caps-aceau.org](mailto:amanda.crompton@caps-aceau.org) as an attachment;  
Only posters created in PowerPoint or PDF format will be accepted;  
Posters must measure 4'x3' in dimension;  
Any borrowed images that appear on the poster must include a reference to the original source;  
Your poster will be printed and displayed for you by the CAPS-ACÉAU committee free of charge.

## Video Presentation Directives

The length of each video presentation should be 5-10 minutes;  
We encourage groups of students to create a video together, highlighting your local or regional planning initiatives;  
Video presentations will be played on the main stage screen during the wine and cheese reception on February 4<sup>th</sup>, 2011;  
Video files should be identified with the presenter's last name and brought on a USB key or CD which will be returned to presenters immediately after the wine and cheese reception.
